Development Director

Reporting to the Chief of Staff, the Development Director will cultivate and maintain relationships with diverse partners and manage a robust institutional fundraising plan that supports the long-term growth of the mission. This position will be part of the Strategy team and located in our East Palo Alto and San Francisco, California offices.

The Development Director will be responsible for creating a strong fundraising strategy targeting mission aligned investors, philanthropists, corporate partners, and government agencies. The Development Director will focus on partner cultivation, value creation and management as well as researching new funding opportunities, and building an expanding portfolio of institutional funders. The Development Director will work in collaboration with a team of partnership builders across the organization.

The ideal candidate will be an entrepreneurial professional with a strong track record of fundraising success, exceptional writing skills, organizational leadership experience, a talent for convening, a passion for the mission, and the ability to communicate Elemental Excelerator's vision and impact to a diverse group of constituents.

The Development Director's responsibilities include:

Overall Development Strategy and Donor Cultivation (60%):

- Develop and lead an effective fundraising plan that ensures long-term growth of Elemental Excelerator and increasing foundation and donor support
- Work directly with the CEO and Chief of Staff on key strategic fundraising initiatives
- Expand an existing portfolio of foundations, high net worth individuals, corporations, and government in order to increase revenue from institutional funders
- Develop and execute tailored campaigns to reach new donors and donor segments
- Cultivate positive and productive relationships with funders, including creative communications campaigns and integration into existing or new events
- Support the organization's existing donor relationships, providing the structures and insights for the CEO and team to engage with the overall fundraising strategy and individual donors at the optimum level
- Track trends and new opportunities to ensure that the case for support expresses Elemental Excelerator's unique value proposition and takes into account donor interests and trends

Project Management (30%):

- Manage all activities related to institutional fundraising efforts, including proposals, reports, and other deliverables
- Collaborate and coordinate across the Elemental team on communications, proposals, and other efforts
- Manage development contacts and communications

Board Relationships and Interfacing (10%):

- Activate the existing board, working closely with board members and advisors to help drive their fundraising activities
- Lead development of new board initiatives to increase fundraising engagement, and onboard new board members to increase capacity
- Report out to the full board on fundraising strategy and overall progress at Board meetings.

- Ability to think creatively to build the vision for and lead the short- and long-term fundraising strategy

- Experience managing and leading a team of collaborators to achieve strong fundraising results, and can work across multiple high-level internal and external stakeholders to be able to drive execution
