This position will report to the Director of External Affairs and offers an opportunity to contribute to the growth of our program and companies in our portfolio, working together to address climate change. The Elemental work environment and culture is fast-paced, fun, and results-oriented, offering opportunities to learn, grow, and contribute to a high-performing team.

The key responsibilities for this role are:

- Management of key partnerships with energy and/or transportation partners
 - Contract and project manage, guide, and develop multi-year partnership with energy and/or transportation partners
 - Support portfolio companies on project identification, scoping, deployment and delivery with partners
 - Identify relevant project partners and facilitate introductions for portfolio companies

- Work with government partners to identify and address policy barriers and opportunities
- Conduct annual innovation needs assessments for key partners
- Work with the Director of Innovation - Equity & Access to support "equity out" program deployment in Hawai'i.
- Policy Support
 - Assists with Elemental's government affairs and other policy related consultants;
 - Conduct research, analysis, and evaluation of the effects of proposed legislation at state, county, and federal level;
 - Draft/Prepares policy briefs, testimony, presentation talking points, and other materials.
 - Collect and analyze data regarding the effectiveness of projects, policies, key metrics, and needs within the data circle.

- Operations
 - Manage deliverables and contracts for relevant contracts
